GRADE 3 READING

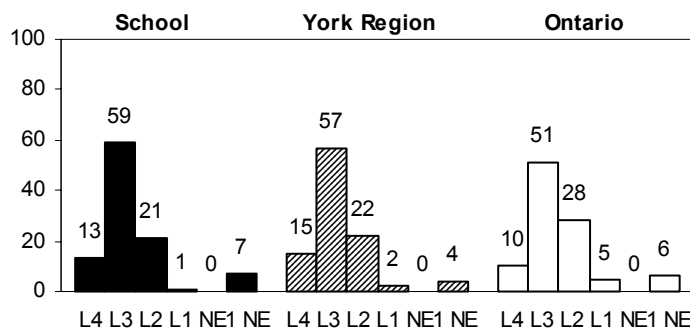
The York Region District School Board's Grade 3 students who were enrolled in a French Immersion program did not participate in the reading assessment. Therefore, no results are available.

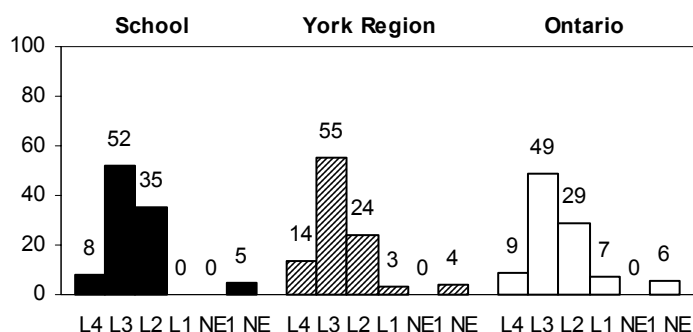

OVERALL ACHIEVEMENT IN READING, WRITING AND MATHEMATICS

L4 (Level 4) - Always or almost always demonstrates expected knowledge, understanding and application of skills.

NE1 (Not Enough Evidence for Level 1) - Students provided enough information to score but have not demonstrated enough evidence to be assigned Level 1.
NE (Not Enough Information to Score) - Student work was insufficient to be assigned a level of achievement due to large sections of work missing.
ND (No Data) - Students from whom EQAO did not receive completed assessment booklets.
EX (Exempt) - Students for whom exemptions were permitted according to EQAO guidelines.

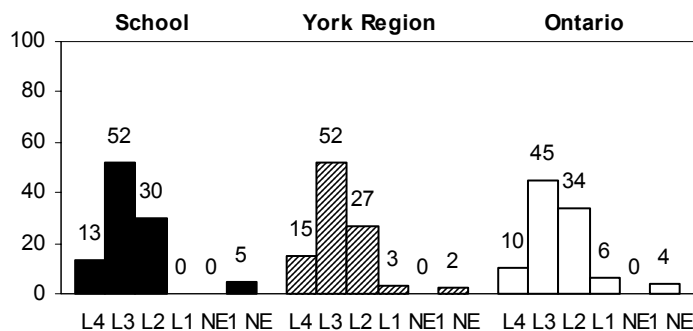

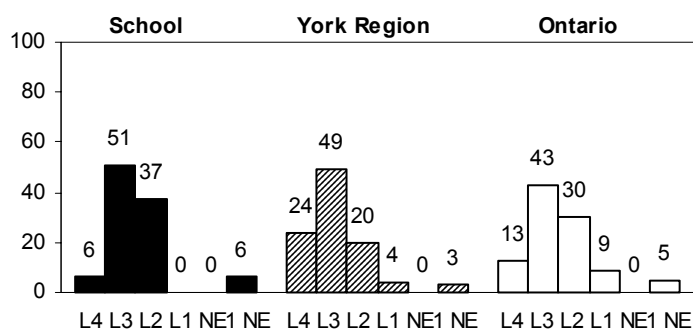
