GRADE 3 READING

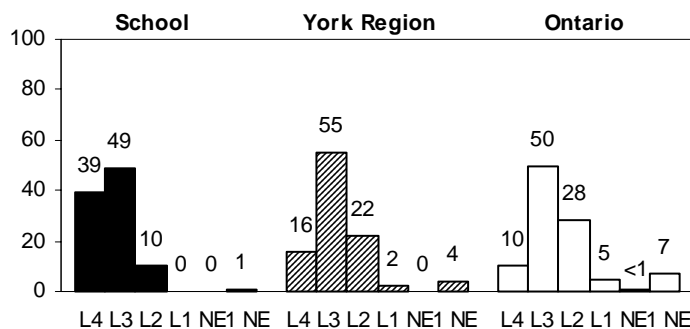
The York Region District School Board's Grade 3 students who were enrolled in a French Immersion program did not participate in the reading assessment. Therefore, no results are available.

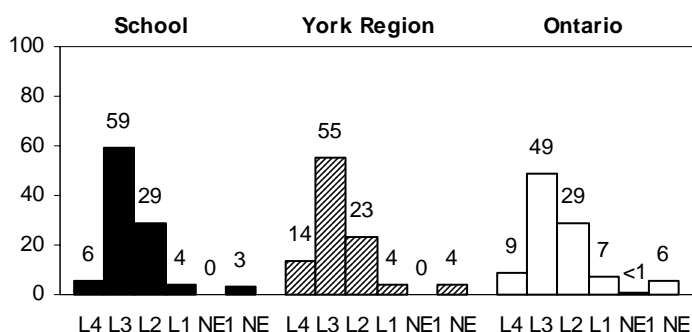

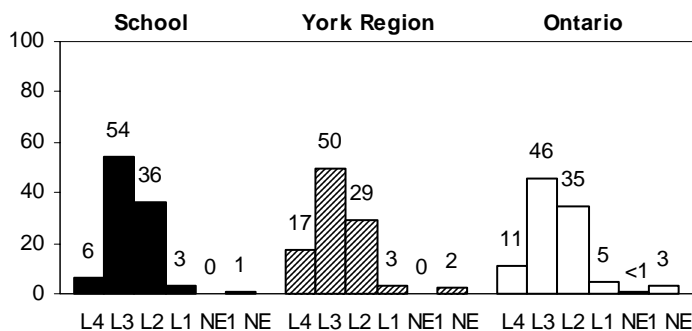

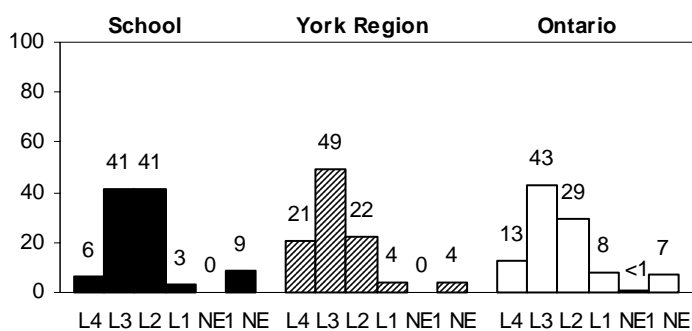
