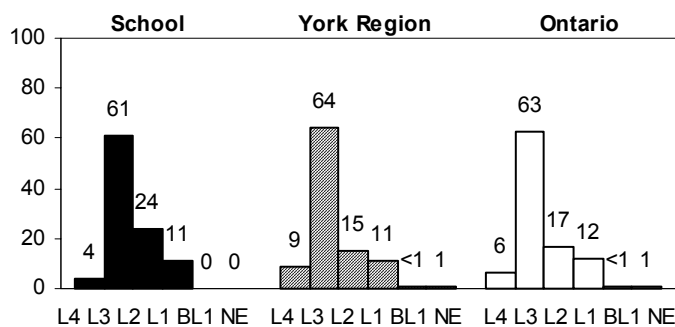

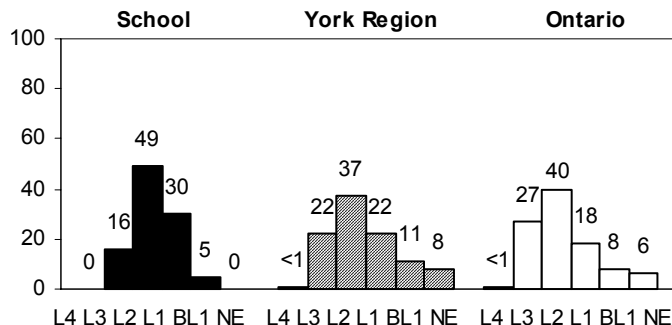
Percentage of Participating Students at Each Level
