Top Scholars 2009-10

Aurora – The York Region District School Board’s top scholar for 2010 is **Evan Feldstein** of **Westmount Collegiate Institute**. Evan achieved an overall average of 99.83%.

In 2009-10, there were 4,232 Ontario Scholars (students with an average mark of 80% or better) within the York Region District School Board. This is a six percent increase from last year, which had 3,978 Ontario Scholars.
