Group 1: 1 additional credit in English, or French as a second language, or a Native language, or a Classical or an International Language, or Social Science and the Humanities, or Canadian and World Studies, or Guidance and Career Education, or Cooperative Education***

Group 2: 1 additional credit in Health and Physical Education, or the Arts, or Business Studies, or Cooperative Education***

Group 3: 1 additional credit in Science, or Technological Education including Broadbased-Technology and Computer Studies, or Cooperative Education***

* A maximum of 3 credits in English as a second language (ESL) or English literacy development (ELD) may be counted towards the 4 compulsory credits in English, but the fourth must be a credit earned for a Grade 12 compulsory English course.

** Students may take one or more Healthy Active Living Education courses for credit in Grades 9, 10, 11 and 12.

*** A maximum of 2 credits in Cooperative Education can count as compulsory credits.

In addition to the 18 compulsory credits, students must successfully complete:

- ✓ 12 optional credits (may include up to four credits achieved through approved Dual Credit courses)
- ✓ The Ontario Secondary School Literacy Requirement (OSSLT or OSSLC)
- ✓ 40 hours of community involvement activities
