

# Elementary Boundary Description

## James Robinson Public School

### North:

- From the intersection of the centre line of McCowan Road and the back of the lots on the south side of Raymerville Drive
- East to the back of the lots on the west side of Stargell Crescent
- Southeast along the back of the lots to the railway tracks
- East along the railway tracks to the back of the lots on the east side of Graham Crescent
- North along the back of the lots of Blackcherry Drive
- Northwest along the back of the lots to the back of the lots on the west side of Beck Drive (including 14 & 17 Beck Drive)
- Northeast along the back of the lots on the west side of Beck Drive to the tributary (Rouge)
- Southeast along the tributary to the point of intersection with Highway 7 (mid-way between HawkrIDGE Avenue and Main Street, Markham)

### South:

- From the intersection of the Rouge Tributary and the centre line of Highway 7 (mid-way between HawkrIDGE Avenue and Main Street, Markham)
- West to the centre line of McCowan Road

### West:

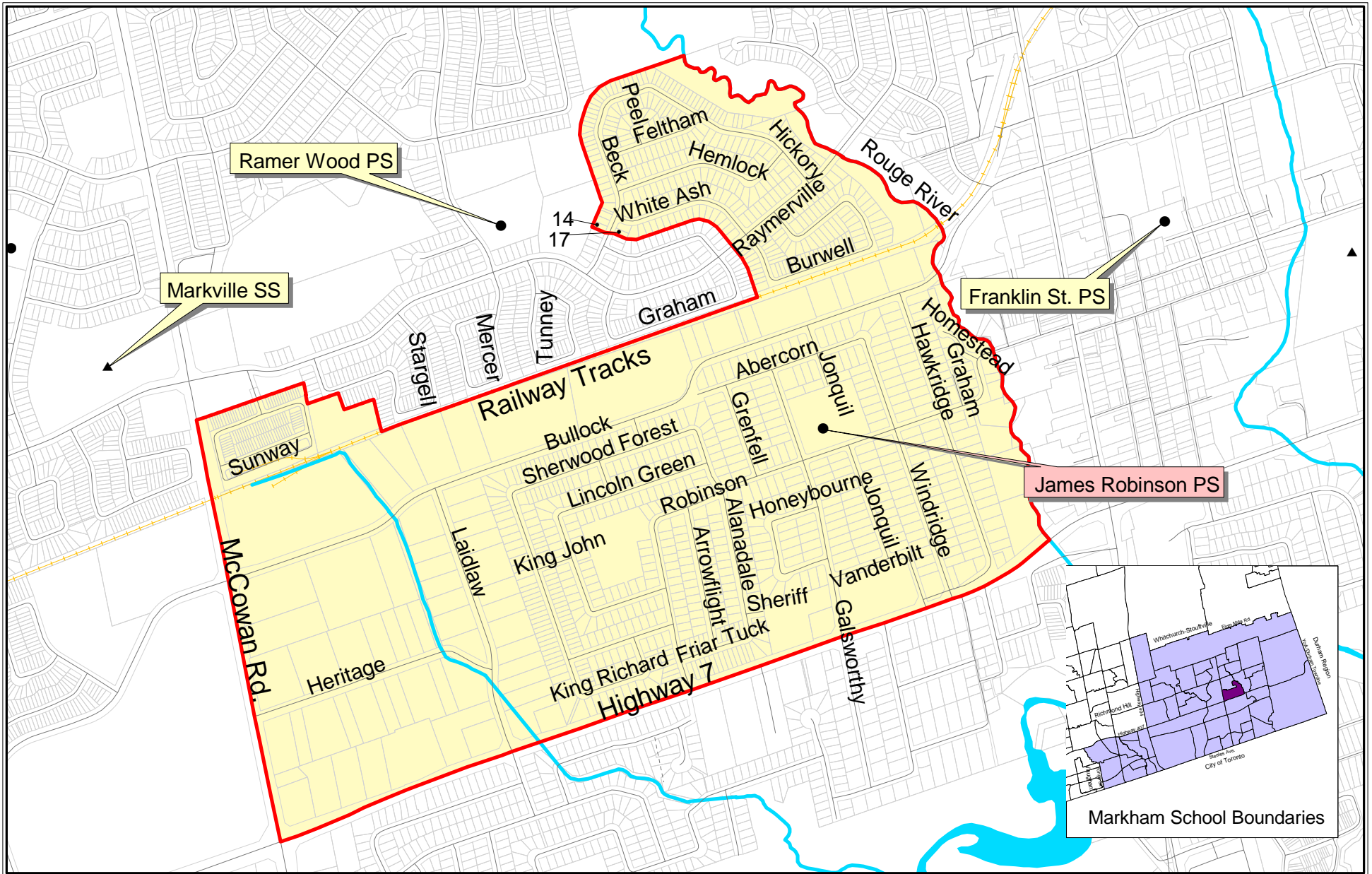
- From the intersection of the centre line of Highway 7 and the centre line of McCowan Road
- North to the back of the lots on the south side of Raymerville Drive
